The 2024-25 application fee for a new distributor licence is \$205.65.

If you intend to undertake the export of dairy products to foreign markets, please contact the Australian Department of Agriculture and Water Resources. Further information can be found here: [Exporting Dairy Products From Australia](#).

If you are unsure as to which licence may be applicable to your specific activities, please provide DFSV with a statement of intent (via email to info@dairysafe.vic.gov.au) that accurately and fully describes the products and processes you will be undertaking. This will assist DFSV to accurately assess what dairy licence best fits your business needs.

If you distribute less than 50% dairy products as a proportion of total distribution, please contact DFSV directly for further discussion on your licensing needs.

Please note that it may take up to 30 days for a distributor licence to be approved.

You are also advised that, under the provisions of the *Dairy Act 2000*, it is unlawful to engage in dairy farming, carrying, manufacturing or distribution activities in relation to Dairy Products until such time as a relevant licence has been issued authorising those activities.
